Establishing a Recovery Plan and Exploring Healing

A closed, five month therapy group for women whose partners are in recovery from sexual addiction or sexual compulsivity.

The addict is often the focus of treatment and the partner's pain is often overlooked or seen as secondary. This group is an opportunity for partners to get the support they need in a safe and caring environment. It is a time to look at the issues that you bring to the table so that you can learn from this painful experience.

This experiential group will focus on the following;

1. Breaking through denial
2. Understanding a common set of behavioural issues;
Denial, preoccupation, enabling, rescuing, taking excessive responsibility, emotional turmoil, efforts to control, compromise of self, anger and sexual issues.
3. Surrendering to the process ... what does recovery look like?
4. Understanding the link with co-dependency
5. Defining and establishing a recovery plan
6. Participating in a culture of support
